Introduction

At St Thomas More Primary School we are committed to ensuring a respectful learning environment that is safe, positive and supportive for all our students.

This Code of Conduct applies to all St Thomas More students. It applies in all school and school related activities and at all times when wearing the school uniform.

This Code of Conduct is based on the following principles that everyone at St Thomas More Primary School:

- has the right to be safe
- has the right to be treated with respect and be valued
- has the right to participate
- is encouraged to be respectful, polite, courteous and considerate of others
- has the right to be supported and challenged as ongoing learners.

Expected Conduct of all Students

It is expected that every student will:

- uphold our school values of Respect, Integrity, Service and Empathy
- behave in a way that does not endanger the health, safety and wellbeing of themselves or others
- follow all health and safety rules
- observe school rules and teacher directions
- follow the Student ICT Responsible Use Agreement
- be respectful, kind and considerate of others
- report any behaviour of other students that is harmful to others or the school
- support other students, or seek help for students who need assistance
- respect school property and the property of others
- play in the correct play areas
- complete work set by teachers to the best of their ability
- wear their school uniform correctly

Unacceptable Conduct

Unacceptable conduct includes:

- being unkind to others
- name calling
- hurting others
- any form of bullying, including cyber bullying
- taking or damaging things that belong to others
- the use of inappropriate language
- disrupting the learning of others
- being disrespectful to teachers and other staff
- going into out-of-bounds areas without permission
